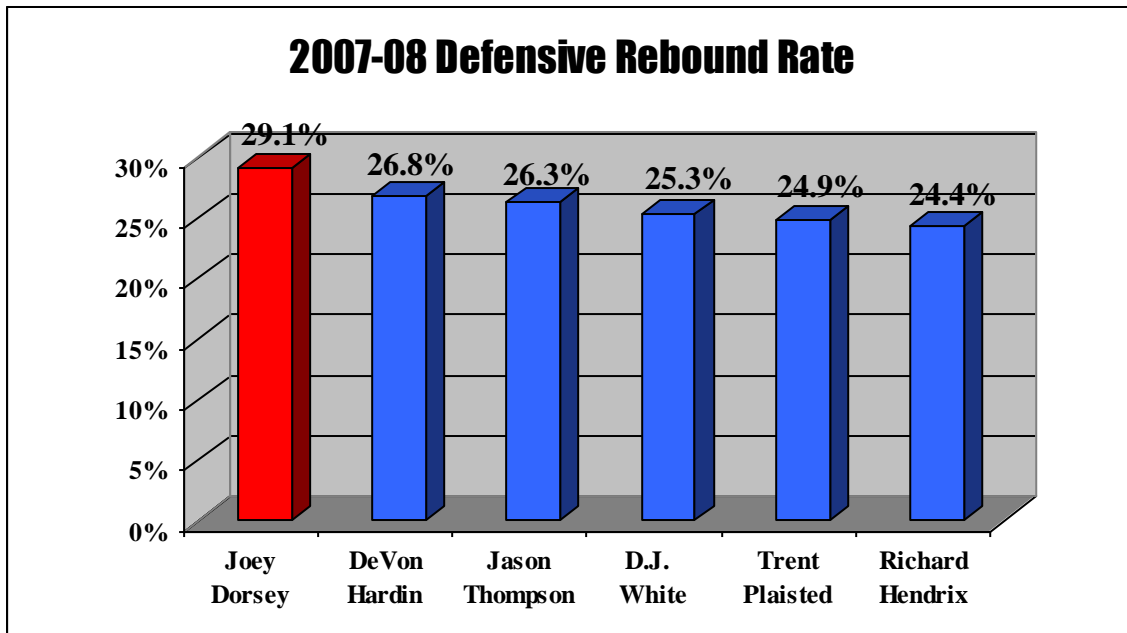


# Joey Dorsey – An Inside Force

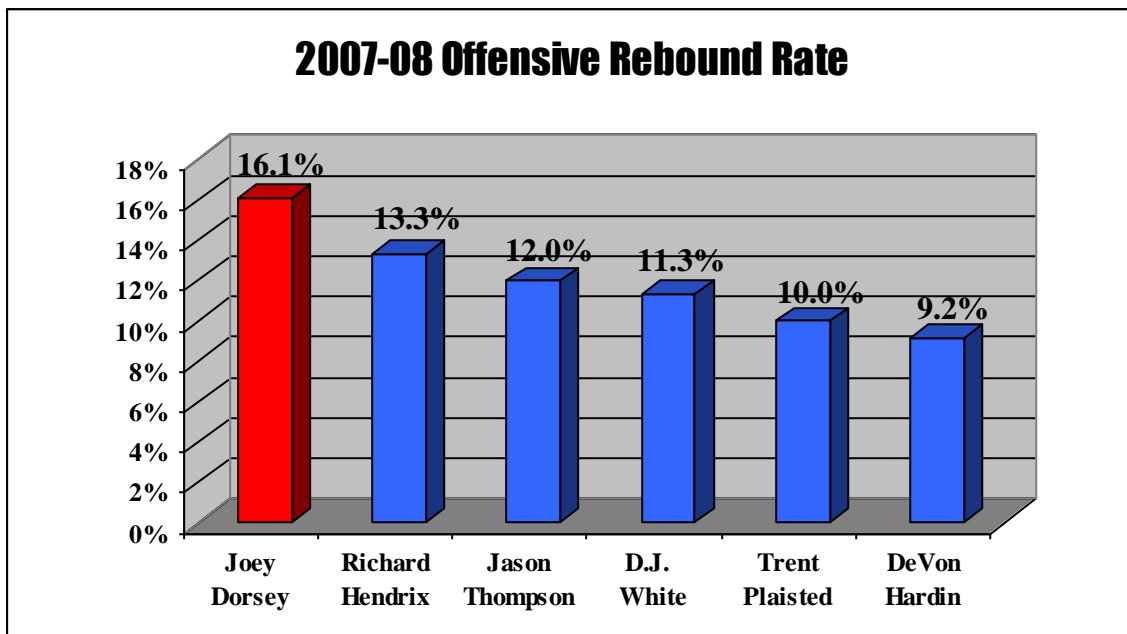
- **A dominant rebounder and standout interior defender**
- Major factor in team's 23-0 start
- Posts **off-the-charts rebounding stats** when adjusted for playing time and context
- Ranked 6<sup>th</sup> in the nation in rebounds per game (11.1) despite getting only 25.4 minutes per contest (through February 10)
- Had grabbed a **sensational 6.14 offensive boards** per 40 minutes
- Snagged over 29 percent of the missed shot attempts by Memphis opponents while on the court
- Had **blocked 9.28 percent of opposing teams' field goal attempts** inside the three-point line
- Led Memphis to the **nation's #1 defensive efficiency figure** (82.94 points allowed per 100 possessions)
- Huge factor in team's outstanding 37.1 field goal percentage defense figure (4<sup>th</sup>-best in nation)
- Had hit an **amazing 72.3 percent of his shots**, which tops every player in the country
- Makes the most of his offensive opportunities – **scoring a remarkably-efficient 1.72 points per field goal attempt**
- Gets fouled at an extremely high rate – had shot .83 free throws per field goal attempt this season
- Despite playing down low, had registered 1.8 steals per 40 minutes

\* - Excluded upper classmen big men likely to be taken much higher or lower than Dorsey, such as Roy Hibbert

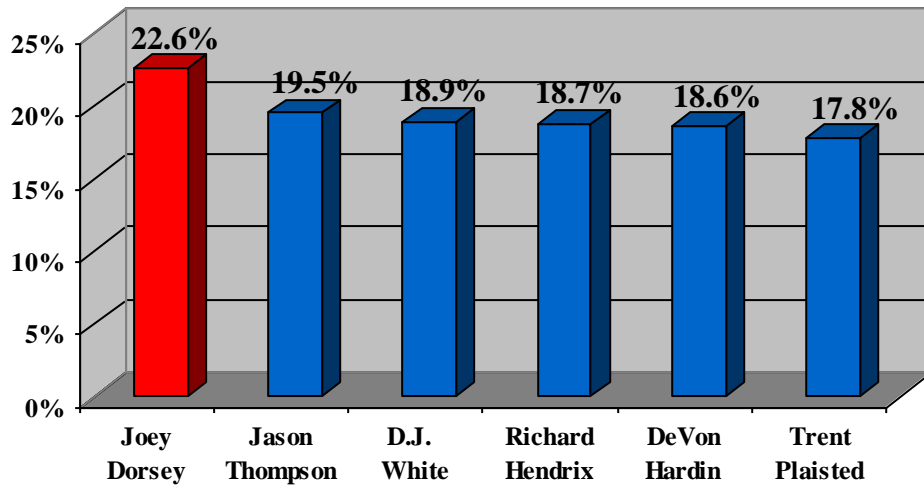


- Dorsey had grabbed a much higher percentage of the available defensive rebounds than the other players (through February 10)



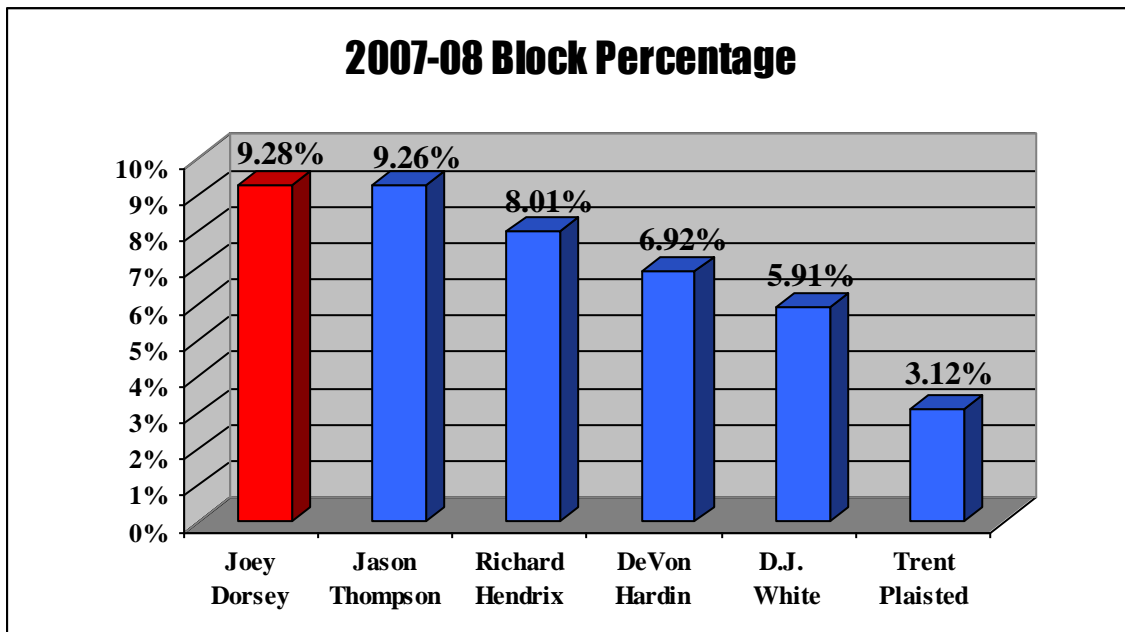
- Dorsey also topped the other big men in offensive rebound rate

## 2007-08 Rebound Rate

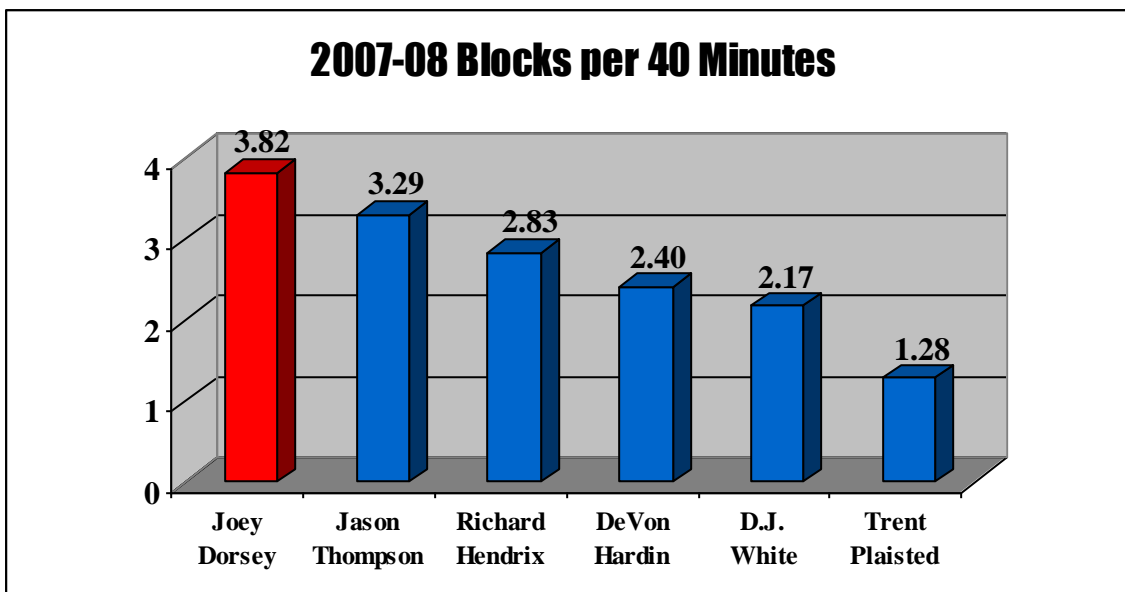


- None of the other players approached Dorsey's overall rebound rate

# Stellar Interior Defense: Shot-Blocking Comparison to Upper Classmen Big Men in the 2008 NBA Draft

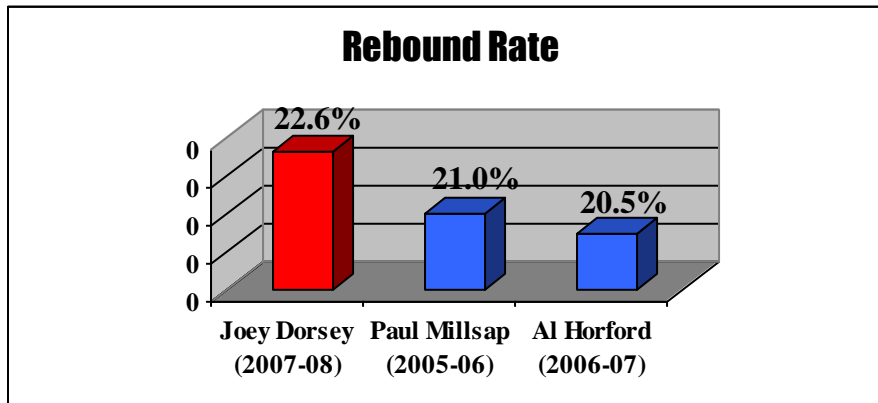


- While on the court this season, Dorsey had blocked over 9 percent of the opponent's two-point field goal attempts

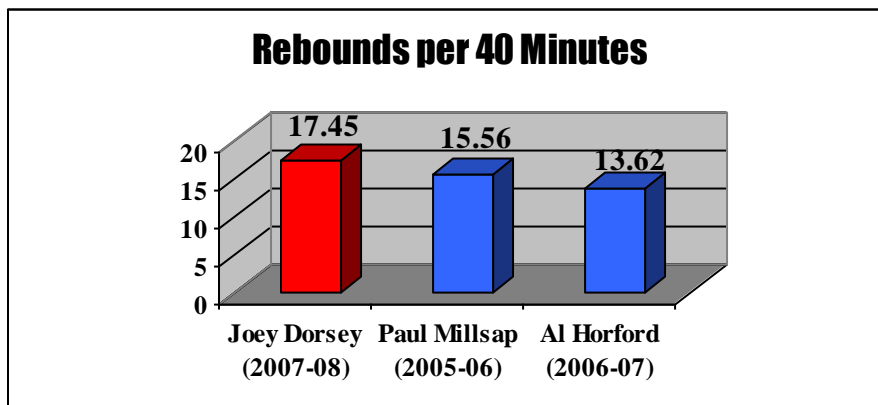


- Dorsey also led the group in blocks per 40 minutes

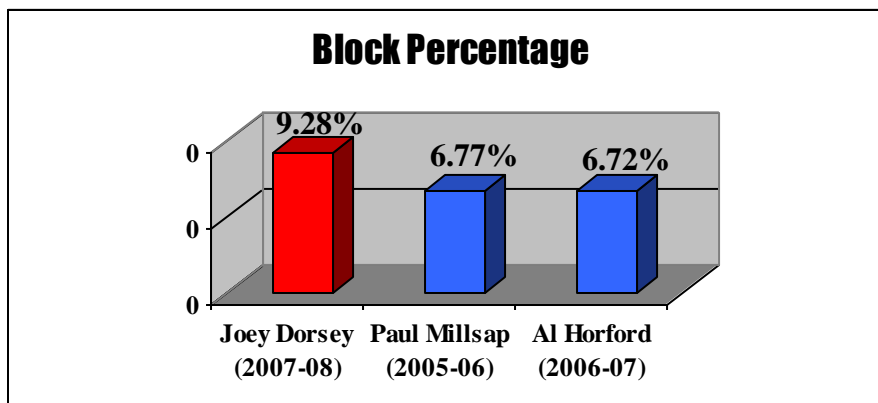
# Final College Season Comparison to Great Rebounders from Past Two NBA Drafts



- Dorsey grabbed the highest percentage of all possible rebounds



- Dorsey had the most rebounds per 40 minutes by far



- Neither of the other players could match Dorsey's defensive contribution this season
